**Re: Response to the post-election report for the CPSU SPSF Group Victorian Branch (E2024/15)**

I write in response to the post-election report published by the AEC on the 2025 elections for the Community and Public Sector Union, State Public Services Federation Group, Victorian Branch (E2024/15), dated 11 November 2025. On behalf of the Branch, I would like to thank you and the other officers working at the AEC for your diligent and professional conduct during the election.

As noted in that report, under Section 198 of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009*, where the AEC identifies a rule that was difficult to interpret or apply in the relevant Section 197 Post-election report, the organisation or branch in question must provide a written response to the AEC on that aspect of the report within 30 days.

The post-election report identifies one rule, namely Chapter C SPSF Rule 37.3, as difficult to apply. It recommends that this rule be updated using the model rules published by the Fair Work Commission.

I can confirm that the Victorian Branch, in conjunction with the other Branches of the CPSU SPSF Group, intends to change Rule 37.3 as part of a comprehensive review of the Chapter C rules of the Group. This comprehensive review of the Chapter C Rules, and the processes required to change those rules, will be completed no later than 31 December 2026.

I trust that this correspondence satisfies the statutory requirements of Section 198 of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009*. Please do not hesitate to contact me if the AEC requires any further information from the Branch for that purpose.
